

Instructions for Use

Applying the Mask | Prior to donning or doffing, ensure hand hygiene is undertaken.

Once the mask is applied it should not be touched or reapplied. Please discard safely after use.

Ear Loop



 Hold the mask on the short edges with the ear loop connection points facing outward.



 Holding firmly on to the nose piece, place one ear loop around the back of your ear and ensure it is secure



Place the second ear loop up over your other ear and check the mask is evenly aligned on your face.



Expand the pleats to ensure a secure and comfortable fit.

Visor and Head Ties



- Before fitting, peel-off visor protectors from both sides of the visor
- Continue with Step 1 of fitting the head ties mask.





 Position mask over the nose with the blue side facing outward and the wire nose piece at the top. Pinch firmly on nose piece to shape over the nose.



Holding the nose piece, expand the pleats to fit over the chin. Pull the upper two ties to the crown of the head and tie a bow.



Tie the lower ties at the nape of the neck Expand pleats to ensure they are covering the nose and chin.



 Check nose piece to ensure a comfortable and secure fit. Reshape if required.

Inclusion on the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods (ARTG)
