

Instructions for Use

Applying the Mask | Prior to donning or doffing, ensure hand hygiene is undertaken.

Once the mask is applied it should not be touched or reapplied. Please discard safely after use.



 Before fitting, peel-off visor protectors from both sides of the visor.



Holding the top of the mask, bend the mask gently toward you creating a gentle curve in the nose wire.



Adjust your hands, gripping the top and bottom of the mask only to expand the pleats.



 Pull the upper two ties to the crown of the head and tie a bow. Tie the lower ties at the nape of the neck.



 Check the nosepiece to ensure a comfortable and secure fit and ensure mask is covering the nose and chin. Reshape if required.

Removing the Mask



 Without touching the mask and leaning forward, untie the bows at the back of the head, starting with the bottom one.



 While untying the top bow, maintain control of the of head tie tension, whilst slowly removing the mask away from the face.
Ensure the mask does not flick forward or back onto the face.



3. Discard the mask safely and ensure hand hygiene is performed once the mask has been discarded.

Inclusion on the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods (ARTG)

Storage Recommendations

Storage temperature -20°C to +30°C at <80% relative humidity. When stored in accordance with recommendations, the product is designed for use within 5 years from date of manufacture.
